

- Our Poppy Lodge offers dedicated dementia care with each resident

- Experienced, registered nurses and a team of care assistants provide 24-hour care, plus an Occupational Therapist and Physio onsite
- Each resident has a personalised care plan as well as an assigned nurse and/or keyworker
- Our new Community Hub and café offers a welcoming, multipurpose space, open to all. Hosting groups, wellbeing activities and events, the Community Hub allows people to connect with new friends, the Armed Forces community, and the wider work of the RBL.
