What makes Mais House so unique?

Whether you're planning for your own future or looking on behalf of a loved one, here are a few of the features that make our care home special.

- It's a community designed exclusively for ex-serving personnel and their families, where everyone, whether you're visiting, working, or staying, has fun and looks out for each other
- There's a food forum every three months, where caterers and residents come together to help make choices about the menus
- The unique octagonal dining room was designed by our residents, using lamb's wool on the ceiling to capture vibrations to help those with hearing difficulties
- We hold regular events to get the local community involved, such as inviting local school children to a Teddy Bears Picnic on the grounds
- A regular minibus service takes residents out for day trips, and there are always lots of activities at the house
- Experienced registered nurses and a team of care assistants provide 24-hour care, plus an aromatherapist, hairdresser and masseuse on site
