When will The Poppy Collection® be available from M&S?

There are 14 products in The Poppy Collection® across Womenswear and Menswear.

Products are available to purchase in stores and online between October – November 2020 or until stocks last. A smaller selection of menswear products, including cufflinks, tie and socks are available to purchase year round in selected stores and online.

How much are M&S donating to the Legion?

M&S is donating all profits from the sale of The Poppy Collection® to the Legion and the aim is to raise over £400,000 for the Legion in 2020.

The funds raised will go towards the Legion's Admiral Nurse Service. Admiral Nurses are specialist nurses who aim to improve the life of both people with dementia and their carers.

By working primarily with the carer offering information, support, therapeutic interventions and education the service is designed to meet to the health, emotional and practical needs of families affected by the condition.

Are M&S donations used to support service throughout England, Wales, Northern Ireland and Scotland?

All profits from sales of The Poppy Collection® in Scottish stores are donated to Poppyscotland.

All profits from sales of The Poppy Collection® across the rest of the UK will support The Royal British Legion's work in England, Northern Ireland and Wales.

Why are M&S not donating the full RRP price to the Legion?

There are many costs involved including buying the stock, VAT, packaging and distribution to name a few. M&S is donating all of the profits after all costs are taken into account.

How much has The Poppy Collection® raised so far?

Since 2012 The Poppy Collection® has raised over £7m for the Legion, and in 2020 they are aiming to raise an additional over £400,000.
