<p>Covid 19 - vulnerable people Staff, volunteers may be clinically vulnerable and more susceptible to Covid 19 and/or effects</p> <p>Beneficiary may be more clinically vulnerable</p> <p>Household member may be clinically vulnerable</p> <p>Someone in the household may be shielding</p>	<p>Staff Beneficiaries Members of the household where visit is taking place Clinically vulnerable people may be at an increased risk of catching and/or effects of Covid 19.</p> <p>Shielding people are at high risk if they contract Covid 19 so need to be protected from the risk of catching it</p>	<p>Complete health questionnaire before returning to work in the community, Enable BAME and others with pre-existing conditions to identify as clinically vulnerable. Support all staff with a specific risk assessment and control measures, including working from home and conducting remote meetings/interviews and assessments. Provide masks or visors to support individual needs.
